

Audrey Hepburn, Marilyn Monroe, Grace Kelly and more given modern day makeover: See their transformations

Some of the most iconic stars from across the world have been given a 2015 look — and some are completely transformed

World famous stars such as Audrey Hepburn and Marilyn Monroe will always be memorable for their striking appearances and period fashion, but thanks to one artist, they've all been given a modern makeover. And unsurprisingly, they're just as stunning in 2015.

The art project brings some of Hollywood's biggest stars into the 21st century.

The pictures were created by a team of digital artists challenged by technology company to use their phones to come up with the images of how they would look if photographed now.

And the change is startling for brunette beauty Audrey, whose iconic up-do is replaced with a messier bun and a simple black strapless dress.

Meanwhile Marilyn looked

like she'd mingle in perfectly on a modern day red carpet in a plunging light dress, flaunting major side boob and her striking blonde hair.

Rebel without a cause James Dean has been transformed into a hipster with a tattoo.

The actor, famous for his trademark blue jeans and white T-shirt who died in 1955, has been given a full-sleeve tattoo, longer hair and a full beard.

Other famous faces getting a modern makeover, include Elvis Presley who keeps his quiff but gets stubble and an earring, Richard Burton and Grace Kelly.

The artistic team, led by digital designer Quentin Devine, worked with cultural studies professor Will Brooker to predict how the stars would have looked now.

Prof Brooker said Dean "may have pushed his rebellion further in the present day".

He said: "The star of *Rebel Without A Cause* was the original hipster who established a timeless teenage look with his laid-back combination of zip jacket, blue jeans and white T-shirt — the bad boy with sad eyes and a secret heartbreak."

The technology company's marketing director Ines van Gennip said: "Audrey Hepburn, James Dean and Marilyn Monroe practically invented style as we know it today, so we thought it would be fun in the run-up to both London Fashion Week and the Oscars to imagine how these stars may have looked had they lived in the present time."

Avoid duck lips after lip augmentation
I am getting engaged next month and want fuller, natural looking lips but don't want duck lips like certain celebrities. Which lip injection techniques gives natural looking lips?

The injection technique may be less important than the level of conservatism. I recommend that the product be injected in a graduated fashion over a period of time. You can then be a part of the lip design and your level of comfort determines the end point. Many celebrities have overdone their lips because they have had a large amount injected into the body of the lip causing them to roll out, giving them the ducky look. Ultimately it comes down to the product being used, and the skill of the injector.

Give uneven breasts a natural look
I have asymmetric breasts and would like to know what surgery you would advise. I am looking for a natural look that will even out my breasts...

The best way to approach correcting breast asymmetry is to have realistic expectations as to what can be achieved. Sometimes, breast asymmetry is approached in a staged fashion. First you should decide which breast you like best and discuss with your plastic surgeon how you can best get your opposite breast to match. This may require an implant, reduction, lift or augmentation with lift. Because there are so many options, I would recommend scheduling a consultation with a certified plastic surgeon for an evaluation and to discuss your options.
